Recently, we supported Barangay Calabuso, Tagatay City in rehabilitating its Senior Citizen Assistance Center (SCAC) by donating painting materials and repurposed furniture for the benefit of over 50 individuals. Present during the turnover ceremony were Ms. Flaviana Aala, President of Calabuso Citizens Group, and her fellow officers. They thanked Belle Corporation for providing senior citizens a venue where they can talk about their various concerns and discuss programs that are beneficial to their group.

We have also extended our support to 60 students of Suplang Elementary School in Tanauan, Batangas thru Department of Education's supplemental feeding program. Now on its second year, nutritious meals will be provided to under-nourished students for 120 school days. Ably supported by the school's Parent-Teacher Association, this program aims to help normalize the students' body weight that will allow them go to class regularly and concentrate on their studies.
